The following narrative, not verbatim nor in its entirety, is a summary of my investigations, observations, and actions.

On Saturday July 20, 2019 at approximately 20:50 hours Officer Schwertman #112 was dispatched to a traffic complaint on Highway 61. The complaint was of a "white or silver Ford pickup" that was "all over the road and almost hit several cars" and "speeding up and slowing down".

Officer Schwertman located the vehicle and proceeded to follow the vehicle to verify the complainant's phone statements. Officer Schwertman observed the vehicle failing to maintain it's lane and attempted to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle at the 125 mile marker southbound Highway 61, however, the vehicle failed to yield to Officer Schwertman's marked patrol vehicle that had it's red and blue emergency lights activated. The vehicle proceeded approximately one mile before pulling onto the shoulder of the roadway.

As I overheard Officer Schwertman's radio traffic, I proceeded to the traffic stop location to provide assistance. Upon arrival, I inquired if Officer Schwertman believed the driver to be under the influence after concluding his initial contact. Officer Schwertman advised me he believed the driver to be under the influence of alcohol.

Due to Officer Schwertman having a citizen participating in our department's ride along program, I offered to take over as the primary officer for the case. Officer Schwertman granted me consent and I approached the driver side of the Ford F250 bearing Illinois registration 1988644 (B-truck).

I made contact with the driver, later identified as Scott P. Petrie (DOB: 04/05/1967), and immediately detected a very strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from Mr. Petrie. I asked Mr. Petrie if he had consumed any alcoholic beverages prior to operating the motor vehicle. Mr. Petrie stated he had approximately three alcoholic beverages. I asked where he consumed the alcoholic beverages and Mr. Petrie stated in Wisconsin. I asked approximately how long ago he consumed his last alcoholic beverage and Mr. Petrie stated an hour ago. I asked what type of alcoholic beverages he consumed and Mr. Petrie stated he consumed Miller Light beer. I asked Mr. Petrie if he would be willing to conduct a series of Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFST), which Mr. Petrie consented to. As we conversed, I noted Mr. Petrie's eyes were bloodshot, watery and his speech was slurred.

I asked Mr. Petrie if he preferred to conduct SFST on the shoulder of Highway 61 or relocate to a safer location. Mr. Petrie requested to relocate off of Highway 61. Mr. Petrie was asked to exit the vehicle. I noted as Mr. Petrie exited the vehicle, his actions were slow and deliberate as if he was attempting to focus on his actions. Mr. Petrie's balance was unsteady and he needed support.

Mr. Petrie was placed in the rear of my patrol vehicle and transported to the BP Gas Station

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(21010 North Brady Street) in Mt. Joy to conduct SFST.

SFST's were conducted on a dry level concrete surface which was well lit by my patrol vehicle's headlights, spotlight and my flashlight.

The first test requested was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN). I used my index finger as the stimulus during HGN. I positioned my index finger approximately 12-15 inches from Mr. Petrie's nose and slightly above eye level. As I attempted to administer the test, Mr. Petrie refused to follow the instructions given and then stated a medical professional diagnosed him with Natural Nystagmus. HGN was terminated due to Mr. Petrie's claims.

The second test requested was the Walk and Turn (WAT). I explained, demonstrated and administered the WAT. During the attempts to explain the WAT, Mr. Petrie began too soon after being advised multiple times to wait until instructed to begin. As I administered the WAT, I observed the following clues: Unable to maintain balance in starting position, starts too soon, steps off line, raises arms, misses heel-to-toe, sops walking, wrong number of steps and improper turn.

Eight out of eight clues of impairment were observed in the conclusion of the WAT.

The third test requested was the One Leg Stand (OLS). I explained, demonstrated and administered the OLS. As I administered the OLS, I observed the following clues: puts foot down, raises arms, hops and sways. Note: Mr. Petrie put his foot down after the count of three and refused to continue the OLS.

Four out of four clues of impairment were observed in the conclusion of the OLS.

The fourth test requested was a Preliminary Breath Test (PBT), which Mr. Petrie refused.

Based on my observations, interview, the odor of an alcoholic beverage, and the results of SFST, I transported Mr. Petrie to the Eldridge Police Department. While at the Eldridge Police Department, Mr. Petrie was read the appropriate Implied Consent Advisory and I requested a specimen of his breath for chemical testing to determine his alcohol content. Mr. Petrie refused to provide a breath sample for Datamaster testing. I administratively revoked Mr. Petrie's driving privileges under Implied Consent. Mr. Petrie was served his Implied Consent paperwork.

Mr. Petrie was transported to the Scott County Jail where he was turned over the jail staff. Mr. Petrie was charged with the following:

Operating While Intoxicated (Code of Iowa, Sec. 321J.2(2)(a))
Financial Liability Coverage (Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.20B)
Failure to Carry Registration Card (Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.32)
Failure to Yield to Emergency Vehicle (Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.324)
