

BID FOR BARGAINS GUIDELINES - 2020

1. Give the name of the business and item number if you have it when you call.
2. Phone bids only will be taken. No walk-ins will be accepted. Please limit your calls to a maximum of 4 items. Call 582-5666, 5667, 5626.
3. A complete list of the items to be sold with bidding numbers and photos (when available) is on our web site in alphabetical order at www.wrmj.com under the Features tab.
4. You cannot place a bid via the web site. You do not have to wait for us to read all the items on the air. You can check the web site and start bidding immediately. We will also be streaming the auction through our web site and the WRMJ app.
5. All bids are FINAL! You cannot retract a bid after it has been placed.
6. All winning bidders will be called later on Saturday or Sunday after the auction.
7. Certificates for the items purchased must be paid for and picked up beginning Tuesday morning, FEBRUARY 18, at 9 a.m. We only accept cash or check.
8. The deadline to pick up certificates from the auction is Friday, FEBRUARY 21, by 5 p.m. Anything not paid for by then will be sold to the next highest bidder.
9. Treat all gift certificates as CASH. They can't be replaced! There are expiration dates on most certificates.
10. WRMJ reserves the right to refuse any bid.

We have some special rules concerning fixed price restaurant certificates.

1. Many restaurant certificates are offered at a fixed price and are shown at the top of the list on the WRMJ web site.
2. We will announce the name of the restaurant and the price. If you want to purchase at that fixed price, call in.
3. Each unique caller can purchase **one (1) restaurant certificate per call**, so if you want more, you will have to call again. There is also a limit of **two (2) certificates from each restaurant per caller over the course of the auction** unless noted. *Even if a restaurant is offering three (3) or more different certificates, each caller can only purchase two (2) certificates from that restaurant.*
4. A caller cannot buy a certificate for another person.
5. There are expiration dates on all restaurant certificates!
